Mandatory Language for Monitoring and Reporting Violation Failure to Submit a Disinfectant Level Quarterly Operating Report (DLQOR) MONITORING, ROUTINE (DBP), MAJOR/CHLORINE

The YANTIS WATER DEPARTMENT water system PWS ID 2500010 has violated the monitoring and reporting requirements set by Texas Commission on Environmental Quality (TCEQ) in Title 30, Texas Administrative Code (30 TAC), Section 290, Subchapter F. Public water systems are required to properly disinfect water before distribution, maintain acceptable disinfection residuals within the distribution system, monitor the disinfectant residual at various locations throughout the distribution system, and report the results of that monitoring to the TCEQ on a quarterly basis.

Results of regular monitoring are an indicator of whether or not your drinking water is safe from microbial contamination.

We are taking the following actions to address this issue:

The Yantis Water Department monitored the disinfection residuals within the distribution system as required by TCEQ during the above monitoring period. Yantis Water Department submitted the report to TCEQ as required, but due to causes unknown to the Yantis Water Department, the report failed to reach the intended destination. All future mailed reports will only be sent to TCEQ with receipts and delivery confirmations.
